This Fund seeks to provide long-term capital appreciation by investing primarily in small and mid-capitalization Canadian companies. The Fund is required to maintain a minimum of 70% Canadian securities.

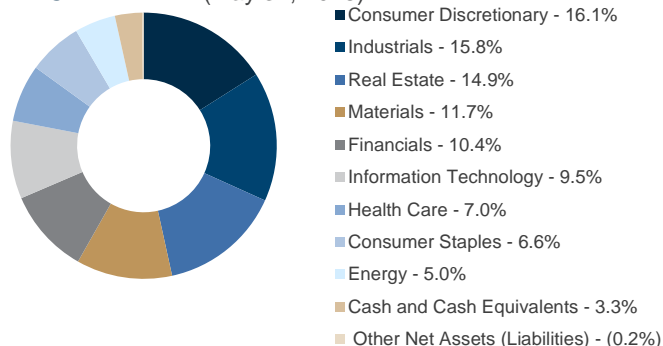

HOW RISKY IS IT?

The value of the Fund can go down as well as up. You could lose money.

One way to gauge risk is to look at how much a fund's returns change over time. This is called "volatility."

In general, funds with higher volatility will have returns that change more over time. They typically have a greater chance of losing money and may have a greater chance of higher returns. Funds with lower volatility tend to have returns that change less over time. They typically have lower returns and may have a lower chance of losing money.

RISK RATING

Matco Financial Inc. has rated the volatility of this Fund as **medium**. This rating is based on how much the Fund's returns have changed from year to year. It doesn't tell you how volatile the fund will be in the future. The rating can change over time. A fund with a low risk can still lose money.

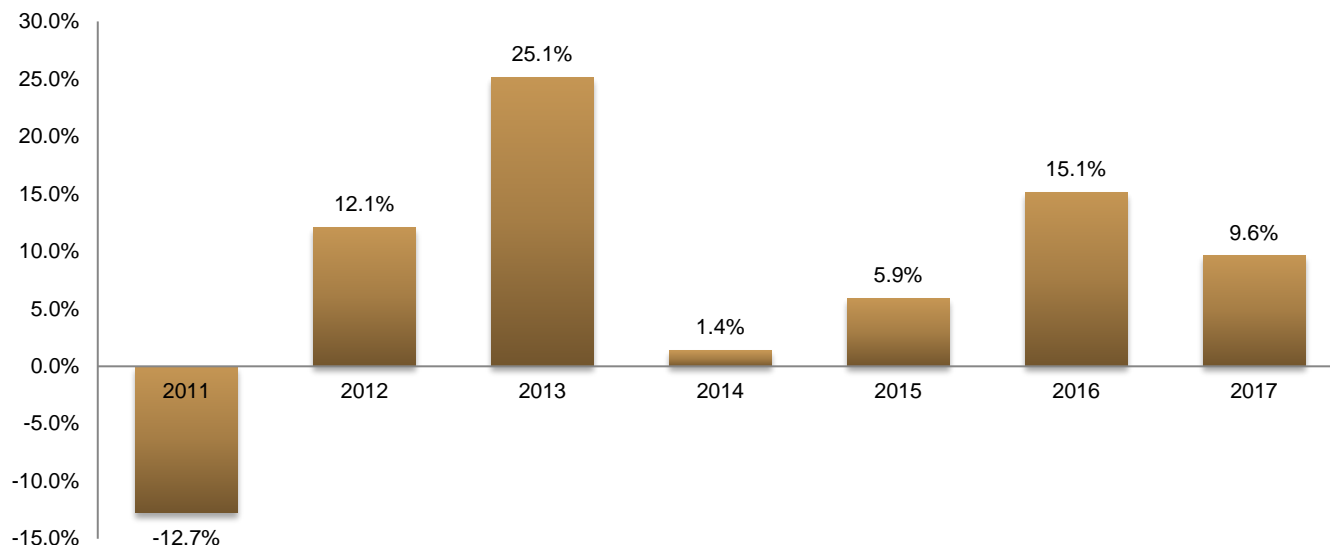
Like most mutual funds, this Fund does not have any guarantees. You may not get back the amount of money you invest.

HOW HAS THE FUND PERFORMED?

This section tells you how the Matco Small Cap Class - Series F shares of the Fund have performed over the past 7 calendar years. Returns are after expenses have been deducted. These expenses reduce the Fund's returns.

YEAR-BY-YEAR RETURNS

This chart shows how the Matco Small Cap Class - Series F shares of the Fund have performed in each of the past 7 calendar years. The Fund dropped in value in 1 of the past 7 calendar years. The range of returns and change from year to year can help you to assess how risky the Fund has been in the past. It does not tell you how the Fund will perform in the future.



BEST AND WORST 3-MONTH RETURNS

This table shows the best and worst returns for the Matco Small Cap Class - Series F shares of the Fund in a 3-month period over the past 7 calendar years. The best and worst 3-month returns could be higher or lower in the future. Consider how much of a loss you could afford to take in a short period of time.

AVERAGE RETURN

As of May 31, 2018, a person who invested \$1,000 in the Series F shares at its inception now has \$2,134. This works out to an annual compound rate of 9.8%, since inception.

WHO IS THIS FUND FOR?

Investors who:

- » are seeking above average capital gain potential;
- » are seeking exposure to high-growth small to mid-capitalization companies;
- » can withstand volatility in the value of the Fund's securities; and
- » can tolerate a medium to high level of investment risk.

A WORD ABOUT TAX

In general, you'll have to pay income tax on any money you make on a fund. How much you pay depends on the tax laws where you live and whether or not you hold the fund in a registered plan such as a Registered Retirement Savings Plan or a Tax-Free Savings Account.

Keep in mind, that if you hold your fund in a non-registered account, fund distributions are included in your taxable income, whether you get them in cash or have them reinvested.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

The following table describes the fees and expenses you could pay to buy, own, and sell Series F shares of the Fund. The fees and expenses, including any commissions, can vary among series of a fund and among funds. Higher commissions can influence representatives to recommend one investment over another. Ask about other funds and investments that may be suitable for you at a lower cost.

SALES CHARGES

There are no sales charges applicable to Series F shares of the Fund. You may be required to pay a separate fee to your representative. The amount of any such fee is determined between yourself and your representative.

FUND EXPENSES

You don't pay these expenses directly. They affect you because they reduce the Fund's returns.

As of December 31, 2017, the Fund's expenses were 1.88% of its value. This equals \$18.80 for every \$1,000 invested.

MORE ABOUT THE TRAILING COMMISSION

Matco Financial Inc. does not pay trailing commission on Series F shares of the Fund.

OTHER FEES

You may have to pay other fees when you buy, hold, sell or switch shares of the Fund.

Fee	What You Pay
Short-Term, Switch or Frequent Trading Fees	2.00% of the value of securities you sell or switch within 90 calendar days of when you acquire, switch from one fund to another, or transfer between different types of accounts. This fee goes to the Fund.
Fee-based Accounts	Series F shares are available to investors who are participants in dealer-sponsored fee-for-service or wrap account programs and whose broker or dealer has entered into an agreement with Matco Financial Inc. Series F shares are also available for direct purchase. You may pay a fee to your representative to participate in such a program.
Referral Fees	Your representative may receive a referral fee in relation to your purchase and/or holding of Series F shares. A referral fee that is paid on continued holdings of Series F is an ongoing fee. The amount of such fee is payable directly by Matco Financial Inc. and is dependent upon individual referral agreements that may be in place between Matco Financial Inc., the representative/referrer, and/or yourself.

WHAT IF I CHANGE MY MIND?

Under securities law in some provinces and territories, you have the right to:

- » withdraw from an agreement to buy mutual funds within two business days after you receive a simplified prospectus, or Fund Facts document, or
- » cancel your purchase within 48 hours after you receive confirmation of purchase.

In some provinces and territories, you also have the right to cancel a purchase, or in some jurisdictions, claim damages, if the simplified prospectus, annual information form, Fund Facts document or financial statements contain a misrepresentation. You must act within the time limit set by the securities law in your province or territory.
