### MANAGEMENT DISCUSSION OF FUND PERFORMANCE

This annual management report of fund performance presents management's view of the significant factors and developments during the period that have affected the fund's performance and outlook. In this report, "Matco" refers to Matco Financial Inc., the Manager of the Fund.

### **Investment Objective and Strategies**

The objective of the Matco Balanced Fund (the "Fund") is to seek a balance of long-term capital appreciation and current income by investing in a Canadian focused portfolio of equities and fixed income instruments, diversified across investment styles and market capitalization, geographic regions, asset classes, and sectors.

The Fund utilizes a risk management framework focused on achieving long term growth while exhibiting lower volatility. Seeking to balance current income and long-term capital appreciation, the Fund invests in Canadian equities, global equities and investment grade fixed income assets. The portfolio is diversified across market capitalization, asset classes, sectors and geographic regions. This "one-stop" Fund offers diversified sources of ongoing income, preserves capital based on an institutional investment risk management process and provides lower volatility performance.

### Risk

The overall and specific risks of investing in the Fund are as described in the Fund's Simplified Prospectus dated June 5, 2023. There were no material changes to the Fund during the period that affected the overall level of risk associated with an investment in the Fund. The risk rating of the Fund is low-to-medium.

### **Results of Operations**

The Fund's net assets decreased to \$163.1 million at December 31, 2023 from \$169.7 million at December 31, 2022. Total investment income for the year ended December 31, 2023 was \$15.1 million, prior to income and operating expenses, up from \$15.6 million investment loss for year ended December 31, 2022.

With higher interest rates offered in the fixed income asset class within a decelerating earnings growth environment for equities, the asset mix committee favored a tilt towards the more defensive fixed income asset class. As a result, the Fund increased its fixed income exposure. The adjustment was supported by a similar assessment of our economic outlook, Matco's Investment Horizon Indicator, and the risk adjusted return landscape for each asset class.

### **Recent Developments**

North American central banks are in the process of trying to orchestrate a soft landing for the economy. They have spent the last 18 months fighting inflation by increasing interest rates to tighten financial conditions and in turn decelerate the economy. They have made material progress with headline inflation continuing to trend lower, while core inflation remains a challenge. Although equity markets continue to trend higher with flat to negative year-over-year earnings growth, leading economic indicators negative, industrial production contracting the fund favors a tilt to protection over capital growth over the next 12 months. The investment team has laid out three potential scenarios for the economy and markets in 2024. Our portfolio positioning is focused on our baseline scenario, given our expectation of its greater probability. None the less, prudent portfolio management considers all scenarios which will continue to monitor closely.

### **Related Party Transactions**

### Management Fees

Matco provides the Fund with investment management services, including managing the investment portfolio, providing investment analysis and recommendations, making investment decisions, making brokerage arrangements for the purchase and sale of the investment portfolio and providing other services. In return, Matco receives a management fee based on the net assets of the Fund, calculated on a daily basis.

For the year ended December 31, 2023, the Fund incurred management fees payable to Matco of \$182,527 (year ended December 31, 2022 - \$183,238).

### Investment Review Committee

An Investment Review Committee ("IRC") has been established by the Manager in accordance with National Instrument 81-107 Independent Review Committee for Investment Funds ("NI 81-107"). The IRC must review and approve conflict of interest matters as referred by the Manager. The Fund did not refer any related party transactions or conflict of interest matters to the IRC during the year ended December 31, 2023 or 2022.

- (4) The information is prepared in accordance with IFRS which uses the last trade price for investments that are traded in an active market where quoted prices are readily and regularly available. For investments that are not traded in an active market, the Fund uses valuation techniques that maximize the use of relevant observable inputs and minimize the use of unobservable inputs
- (5) This information is provided as at the year shown, as applicable, except Series N for 2018 which are from inception February 6, 2018 through December 31, 2018.
- (6) Management expense ratio is based on total expenses for the stated period and is expressed as an annualized percentage of daily average net asset value during the year/period.
- (7) The Fund's portfolio turnover rate indicates how actively the Fund's portfolio advisor manages its portfolio investments. A portfolio turnover rate of 100% is equivalent to the Fund buying and selling all of the securities in its portfolio once in the course of the period. The higher a fund's portfolio turnover rate in a period, the greater the trading costs payable by the fund in the period, and the greater the chance of an investor receiving taxable capital gains in the period. There is not necessarily a relationship between a high turnover rate and the performance of a fund.
- (8) The trading expense ratio represents total commissions and other portfolio transaction costs expressed as an annualized percentage of daily average net assets during the year/ period.

### **Management Fees**

The annual management fee rate, exclusive of sales taxes, is 1.00% for. No management fees are charged directly to Series O.

During the year ended December 31, 2023, management fees totaled \$182,527 (year ended December 31, 2022 - \$183,238). Included in liabilities at December 31, 2023 is \$15,006 (December 31, 2022 - \$13,845) in respect of these fees.


All management fees paid by Series F were applied to cover portfolio management and other services provided to the Fund by the Manager. No such fees were used to pay for external portfolio advisory fees, trailing or other sales commissions.

### **PAST PERFORMANCE**

Given Matco's private client investor base, who often look at ETFs as a substitute for active investment solutions, the ETF better fulfills the investable portion of the benchmark suitability criteria. Matco has chosen to be consistent across all mandates by benchmarking against ETFs for this reason
